## Introduction

The unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

## **Mode of Delivery**

Delivery of this course will be trainer led and delivered over one day of face-toface in a classroom setting after approximately 8 hours of pre-course online learning, combined with skills practice and assessment in a simulated environment.

#### Assessment

The assessment requires the learner to complete a written knowledge assessment and demonstrate their applied knowledge and skills during a practical assessment.
