Introduction

Course Description

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

Specific licensing/regulatory requirements relating to this competency, including requirements for refresher training should be obtained from the relevant national/state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authorities.

Mode of Delivery

Delivery of this course will be trainer led and face-to-face in a classroom setting combined with skills practice and assessment in a simulated environment.

Assessment

The assessment requires the learner to complete a written knowledge assessment and demonstrate their applied knowledge and skills during a practical assessment.

Course Duration and Location

The course is delivered over 5 hours of face-to-face learning and assessment after approximately 2 hours of pre-course online learning.
