

Introduction

Course Description

This first aid unit provides learners with the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid and is designed to meet the requirements from the HLT Health training package. This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies. This unit applies to a range of workers within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthma and anaphylactic emergencies. This includes early childhood workers and educators who work with school age children in outside school hours care and vacation programs.

Mode of Delivery

Delivery of this course will be trainer led and delivered over one day of face-to-face in a classroom setting after approximately 8 hours of pre-course online learning, combined with skills practice and assessment in a simulated environment.

Assessment

The assessment requires the learner to complete a written knowledge assessment and demonstrate their applied knowledge and skills during a practical assessment.

Course Duration and Location

The course is delivered over one day face-to-face learning and assessment after approximately 8 hours of pre-course online learning.

Learners must be physically capable of bending and kneeling to provide first aid to a person on the floor. This includes performing CPR for a specific amount of time on the manikins.
